While the book speaks for itself, some of its leading features may here be pointed out. (1) It aims at a combination of Euclidean rigor with modern methods of presentation suitable for beginners in the study of demonstrative geometry; but the rigor is not regarded as consisting so much in excessive formality of expression as in soundness of structural development. (2) It regards the postulates as a body of fundamental conventions that constitute a definition of Euclidean space, from which (with the definitions of particular figures) other properties of such space are to be unfolded by a series of logical steps. (3) It regards the postulates of construction as determining or defining the province of elementary as distinguished from higher geometry. Accordingly no hypothetical figure is made the basis of an argument until its construction has been proved to be reducible to the construction postulates; and...
