This book explores the stuff of the earth itself: igneous rocks (granite and basalt), sedimentary rocks (limestone and coal), metamorphic rocks (marble and slate), minerals (gemstones, quartz, opal, and amber), and fossils (arthropods, mollusks, and dinosaurs), as well as what they tell us about extinction and evolution. Illustrated with captioned color photos or drawings on nearly every page, this compact encyclopedia for readers 8 and up is stuffed with detailed information, making it an engaging refresher for adults as well. Each topic is presented in clear, bulleted points, while "Did You Know?" fact panels appear throughout. 384.
